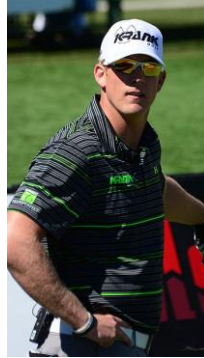




Tim Burke
